

ORDINANCE NO. 549

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-221 OF CHAPTER XV, ARTICLE 2 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WAVERLY, KANSAS PROVIDING FOR AND FIXING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR WATER SOLD BY THE CITY OF WAVERLY, KANSAS; REPEALING ORDINANCE 536, OF THE CITY OF WAVERLY, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WAVERLY, COFFEY COUNTY, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 536 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. That section 15-221 of Chapter XV, Article 2 of the Code of the City of Waverly, Kansas is hereby amended to read as follows:

Water Rates. The following water rates shall be charged and collected from residential and commercial consumers for water sold by the City of Waverly from the Municipal Water System.

- (1) A minimum charge of \$22.00 per month for 1-1,000 gallons furnished.
- (2) For the next 9,000 gallons in one month, the rate shall be \$10.75 per each 1,000 gallons used.
- (3) For water furnished in excess of 10,000 gallons in any one month, the rate shall be \$10.30 per 1,000 gallons used.
- (4) A water reserve fee of \$2.00 per meter.
- (5) Bulk Water Meter System charge of \$15.25 per 1,000 gallons.


SECTION 3. These rates shall be effective for water usage in October 2017 billed on November 1, 2017.

SECTION 4. All other ordinances conflicting with the provisions of the ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. All of the provisions of Chapter XV, Article 2 of the Code of the City of Waverly, Kansas that are consistent with this ordinance are hereby in full force and effect.


SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after publication one (1) time in The Coffey County Republican, the official city newspaper.


