ABOUT YOUR TRASH:

Trash pickup every **TUESDAY**. Trash service is billed on your utility bill along with the water and sewer.

Please have trash out by 6:00 am on Tuesday mornings and placed no more than 2 feet from the curb or road edge. The arrows on the lid must be pointed toward the street, with the hinges facing away from the street. All trash must be bagged and contained in the cart issued, so that the lid is closed. The carts remain the property of Republic Services.

Residents are allowed **one** bulky item per week. No dirt, sod, tires, batteries, concrete, rock, construction or demolition debris, household hazardous waste, hot ashes, flammable materials such as used oil, gas, or paint cans.

Please respect the fact that the city has hired a company to pick up your trash. Please do not allow family and friends from outside the city to bring their trash to your residence.

SPECIAL CITY WIDE CLEANUP DAYS

The City of Waverly provides two city wide cleanup dates. They coincide with the Coffey

County "Clean up Week" annually in the spring and the fall.

Dates will be posted at local businesses of the specific date. All household trash and loose paper must be properly bagged or will NOT be accepted. There will be a charge for TIRES. Separate metals, limbs, lumber, etc.

Metal Items - For City Wide Cleanup Days

Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Hot Water Heaters, Refrigerators, Microwaves, Air-Conditioners, Bicycles, Wagons, Wire, Sheet Metal, etc.

The city will utilize an outside contractor to pick up metal items during clean up week.

Regular Trash Type Items - For City Wide Cleanup Days

The regular Tuesday trash service will be the same as usual. Place polycarts or bags in the same location. Any other items need to be placed along the street in special piles. If you have an item that can be broken down or cut up to make it easy for the trash collector to handle, please do so.

"NO HAZARDOUS MATERIALS"

Old paint cans, oils and gas cans, and any other item that would be considered HAZARDOUS needs to be taken to the Coffey County Landfill.

Open Burning:

County burn permits may be obtained at city hall. There is no charge. You must call the county before burning begins. They will ask for your burn permit number. The county number to call is on your burn permit.

City Burn Site:

The city burn site is open to the residents for natural growth disposal; limbs and branches only. The key can be checked out at City Hall.

Utility Service:

Deposit Required ----- \$100.00

Utility bills are mailed on the 1st workday of the month. If you do not receive a bill, please notify the city clerk.

A 10% late fee will be added to accounts not paid by the 15th of the month. If the 15th and/or the 16th fall on the weekend, late charges will be added on Monday following.

A drop box is located under the window in front of City Hall for, after hour's service. The city does exercise its right to terminate service due to unpaid utility bills. Good communication with the city when a bill is late is always to the benefit of the customer.

Animals:

Dog Tags Required ----- Annual Renewal

\$3.00 = spayed or neutered,

\$5.00 = male or female

Every owner of any dog over six months of age shall annually register with the city clerk his or her name and address with the name, sex and description of each dog owned and kept with the city limits. Upon registration, the owner shall present a current, completed certificate of immunization against rabies.

New residents, within 30 days of locating inside of the city limits, must register their dog(s). Any resident who fails to register his or her dog(s) within the 30 days shall pay a fine. (Code chapter II, article 2 & 3: Revised in 2016)

ATV Tags: Required to ride an ATV on city streets. Tags are available at City Hall. Fee - \$20.00.

PUBLIC BUILDINGS FOR PUBLIC USE:

Community Building and City Park Building

Reservations can be made at city hall for the use of these facilities. There is a fee and deposit for the Community Building and the City Park Building. The deposit will be returned after the building has been inspected for cleanliness and no damages after use. A deposit must be paid to hold a reservation.

City Park Pavilion and Jones Park Shelter

Reservations can be made at city hall for the use of these facilities. There is no charge for using the City Park Pavilion or the Jones Park Shelter by the pool. We do ask that you clean up after your event. A fifty dollar deposit is taken for the bathrooms and will be returned if the bathrooms are clean and undamaged.
